What We're Seeing in June 2026

June 2026 Snapshot

1 The Great Executive Handoff

A wave of executive retirements is creating leadership openings across the industry. Recent searches have included presidents, vice presidents, and regional sales leaders as companies prepare for succession and long-term growth.

These are high-stakes hires, which is why more companies are turning to retained search models. At the same time, extended interview timelines are creating unnecessary risk. The best executive talent isn't staying available for long.

2 Integrity Logistics Is Taking Center Stage

Fraud prevention, compliance, and safety are becoming dedicated functions rather than responsibilities spread across multiple roles.

Recent searches and placements have included compliance officers, safety leaders, and cargo loss prevention specialists focused specifically on reducing risk. As these roles become more critical, companies are raising their standards and becoming increasingly selective about the backgrounds they pursue.

3 Specialized Freight Is Showing Signs of Life

One of the more interesting shifts this month is the increase in hiring tied to flatbed, heavy haul, and construction-related freight.

Multiple flatbed operations openings and capacity-focused sales roles have appeared at the same time. Historically, activity in specialized freight tends to pick up before broader market recovery, making it one of the more closely watched areas of the industry right now.
